Who is a Refugee?

A person is only classified as a refugee if he or she is escaping conflict or persecution in his or her own country and crosses an international border. Remember, the huge number moves without food and is lacking equipment. Instability comes when war destroys schools, farms and houses by tearing up communities and ripping apart families. The breakdown of the social fabric usually quickens the spread of malaria disease.



The condition under which refugees live often leaves them susceptible to malaria. The loss of family, property, food security, access to health care and education can lay a fertile breeding ground for malaria.

Refugees can flee from conflict – but they can't always outrun disease.

Refugees often migrate from conflict-scarred countries like the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Refugees chances of staying healthy while living in a host country can be boosted by Think Humanity with clear and open minded people with good hearts.

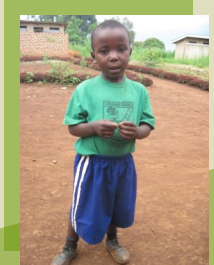
